Idyllic location

Alexandra Park Conference Centre was established in the magnificent beauty of the Sunshine Coast rainforest, a short walk from Alexandra Headland beach, to create an ideal setting for immersive learning experiences. Our centre offers the perfect blend of time in nature and comfortable modern amenities - ideal for school excursions and educational programs..



Accommodation:





Alex Park offers a variety of accommodation options catering to small or large groups. Our rooms accommodate up to 350 people, most with wheelchair accessibility. And yes – the mattresses are comfy!

-  **Bungalows** 18 ensuite rooms, 2 per bungalow building for 106 guests total, with air-conditioning and double bed, plus 4 singles per room (bunk beds)
-  **Banksia** 16 ensuite rooms for 72 guests total, mostly configured with 4 singles per room. (bunk beds). Includes a meeting room seating 70
-  **Pandanus** 6 ensuite rooms for 36 guest total, with a double bed and 4 singles per room (bunk beds)
-  **Acacia** 12 dorm-style rooms for 96 guests total with shared bathroom facilities, ideal for community living. Two leaders' rooms have ensuites, with a meeting room setting 100

Meeting & activity spaces:

Note: Additional beds are added to each option as required = 350-person capacity.

From our versatile meeting rooms we provide spaces customised to your requirements. Our two large auditoriums seat up to 250 each. These can be open together as one large activity space or separated for smaller groups. Ideal for leadership programs, music and drama camps, or conferences and meetings. All meeting rooms are equipped with audio equipment, display monitors or data projectors and screens.

-  **Large auditoriums** Perfect for conferences, meetings and functions.
-  **Bungalows conference room** Close to Bungalow accommodation, seats 130 for group activities, training sessions or daily briefings.
-  **Banksia & Acacia meeting rooms** Attached to accommodation areas, ideal for meetings up to 100 people, group activities or daily briefings.
-  **Individual meeting rooms** Located near or in the main building there are 5 additional smaller rooms ideal for break-out spaces.



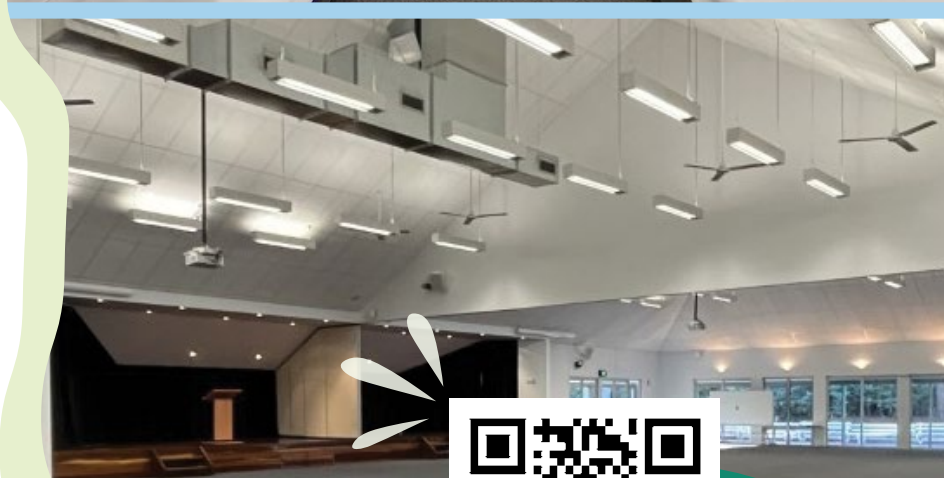
